Its not been easy for the choir losing so many good members and friends but as many of you know membership has its ebbs and flows. We say farewell to these men and we thank them for their friendship and dedication.

Choir Operating model

Over the 25 years of the Choir from time to time the Choir has faced challenges and has needed some change to address those challenges. Today is no exception.

We are currently faced with falling and aging membership more than at any time in our past and a change is required if we are to continue.

At the last AGM the Choir Committee was tasked with presenting a new operating model that is financially secure and allows the Choir to continue and develop in the future.

To achieve this we see three key objectives which we intend to address in a staged manner which will allow us to focus on key priorities in a managed way.

Stage 1: Secure our financial situation for the next 6-12 months.

This is our priority. If we can't do this we will cease to be viable.

Stage 2: Develop an improvement model to lift the choral musicianship standard of the choir. In respect to stage 3, develop our choral musicianship improvement journey both from an individual and choir perspective.

Stage 3: Develop a longer-term operating model for the choir that will be financially sustainable

This will focus on how we can operate in an affordable and sustainable manner that enables taking into account our revenue and liabilities and acknowledging our need for choral musicianship improvement and to attract new membership.

So change is afoot and we are aiming to rebuild the Choir over the next 12-24 months with a higher standard of musicianship that will attract new and younger members from the wider NZ Choral network, and establish a more sustainable future for the Choir.
